Max engine size A class born between, 01.01.2007-31.12.2008 125cc or up to 250cc twinshock B class born between, 01.01.2009-31.12.2012 125cc or up to 250cc twinshock C class born between, 01.01.2012-31.12.2014 80cc D class born between, 01.01.2015-31.12.2018 80cc To ride a combustion engined machine the rider must have attained 6years. E class the rider must be 4 years at the date of competition and will remain in E class until they become eligible for D class. Electric bikes only.
