Organising Club: Trials Training Wales

The above club will promote an Open Youth Trial, which will be held under the National Sporting Code and the Standing Trials Regulations of the Auto Cycle Union, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions that may be given, and the Championship conditions of the Welsh Motorcycle Federation.

Eligibility for Welsh Championship Points

A competitor must be proven Welsh Birth or either parent Welsh Born or have been a continuous resident in Wales for a period of not less than three years prior to the commencement of the Championship. He or she must be fully paid up member of a Welsh Club under the Jurisdiction of the Welsh Motorcycle Federation.

All Riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration card.

Classes: as per Welsh Championship Conditions

Youth A.B.C. D & E Classes eligible for Championship points

Non Welsh Resident eligible for 'Non Welsh Resident Rider' award (1 award per route)

Routes

Clubman - Route 1 – Red & Blue Flags

Inter 50/50 – 50% of Route 1 and 50% of Route 2 – indicated on section start boards

Intermediate - Route 2 – Yellow Flags

Sportsman 50/50 - 50% of Route 2 and 50% of Route 3 – indicated on section start boards

Sportsman - Route 3 – White Flags

E Class riders to compete only on Sportsman Course.

All routes to be marked continuously through each section (ie no deviations).

*Please note - A class riders can enter both the Adult Welsh Championship and the Youth Welsh Championship but can only receive Championship points in one of these Championships. This must be determined at the start of the Championship.

Route 3 – White Flags (Sportsman)

E Class riders to compete only on Sportsman Course.

Course:

4 laps of 6 sections. No overall time limit to complete the course. Not to encourage speeding.

Each Rider may register one Assistant to accompany them on the course. The riders machine must have travelled the whole distance under its own power or the exertion of the rider ie no assistance allowed, if assistance is given a failure will be recorded and a '5' given.

Method of marking: TSR22 – Stop allowed. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23

Results:

Will be announced immediately after the event, rosettes will be awarded to all.
